

Prerequisites:

- PADI Resuce Divers who are at least 18 years old can enroll in the Divemaster Program
- 40 logged dives to begin the course and 60 by certification
- CPR and First Aid Certification within 24 months
- A medical clearance to dive signed by a physician in the last 18 months

PADI Divemaster Course - Tobermory Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why should I do my Divemaster training in Tobermory?

A: There is no question that if you plan to teach in cold water you should train in cold water. Tobermory is the "Shipwreck Diving Capital of Canada" and offers a unique destination for Divemaster training. Our facilities and diving locations are all a stone's throw from each other providing convenience and efficiency. We also don't have a pool! You'll be doing all your training at The Tugs, the confined water training area located just outside the Tobermory Harbor. Training in cold water conditions provides you with the skill set to dive and teach anywhere in the world!

Q: Do I need a drysuit to dive and train in Tobermory?

A: While our water temperatures during peak season do lend themselves to wetsuits, it is important that you are comfortable and capable in a drysuit. Water temperatures at depth in Tobermory remain at around 4C/38F year round. In the shoulder season, the surface temperatures can easily dip down to 10C/50F. A drysuit is a critical component of your equipment if you plan to train and teach in cold water environments.

Q: What other equipment do I need for my Divemaster?

A: As a Divemaster candidate it is important that you are familiar with and own all your own equipment. This will include a wetsuit (7mm+), drysuit (optional), regulator, BCD, SMB & reel, flashlight, slate, mask/fins/snorkel, etc. If you have any questions about the equipment you'll require, or are looking to purchase any of the required equipment, please contact us directly.

Q: What experience should I have to consider doing my Divemaster in Tobermory?

A: Divemasters are required to have a minimum of 60 dives in order to complete your Divemaster course. In our experience, a diver should have a number of cold water dives (cold water being less than 50F) in order to be sufficiently comfortable in this environment to be successful.

Q: Where will I stay while I'm on course?

A: Accommodation is the responsibility of the Divemaster candidate. We have partnered with a couple of local accommodators to assist you with this arrangement. Please contact us for details.
